WHEREAS, those dollars are spent wisely and efficiently through the engineering and facilities management department's diligent efforts to optimize the physical health care environment; and

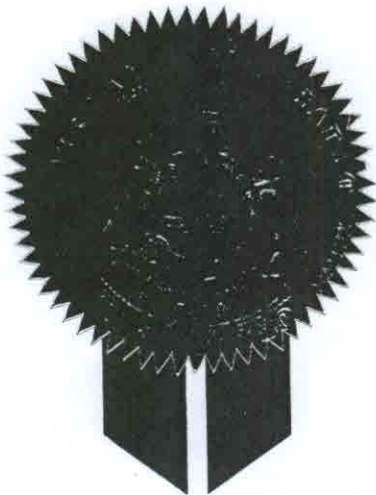
WHEREAS, health care engineering and facilities management professionals make significant contributions to the health of Missourians.


